Notice of Decision for Waiver of Court Fees on the basis of financial hardship

What you may do if your waiver application is refused

Under section 28(1) of the *Administrative Appeals Tribunal Act 1975* you may, within 28 days of receiving this notice, request a statement setting out:

- the findings on material questions of fact
- the evidence or other material on which those findings are based
- the reasons for the decision

You may apply to the Administrative Appeals Tribunal for a review of this decision.

If you wish to proceed with an application, hearing or appeal for which the fee is sought, return your documents to the Court accompanied by the appropriate fee.
